Big Rock Primary School Policy Appropriate Clothing for School

Rationale: Clothing should be appropriate for all school activities and not be offensive to others

Aims:

- To provide guidelines and expectations for appropriate clothing, footwear and jewellery for school
- Children wear clothing appropriate for a primary school and are able to fully take part in all aspects of a school day
- Learn and understand the appropriateness of different clothing for different occasions, including sun safety

Supporting Guidelines

Appropriate Clothing

- Clothing should be appropriate for physical activity and exercise (Trackpants, shorts etc)
- Footwear should be appropriate for physical activity and exercise (Sneakers etc)
- Clothing should be able to be worn inside the classroom and warm enough for outside the classroom
- Clothing should be allowed to get dirty etc as part of everyday school life

Inappropriate Clothing:

- Clothing with adult themed branding (alcohol, smoking, drug use, sex themes, swearing or hand gestures) and racist slogans
- Clothes that expose midriffs, shoulders etc
- Clothes that 'ride up' when lifting arms or bending over
- Short shorts including bike shorts
- Crocs, jandals, scuffs, gumboots & rugby boots are permitted however alternative sports shoes should be available for PE and fitness

Make-Up

Make up is not to be worn at Big Rock Primary School except when required for:

- School plays
- Class plays

Jewellery

At Big Rock the following jewellery may be worn:

- Jewellery of cultural significance (Pounamu, crucifix)
- Stud earrings (Maximum of one per ear)
- A bracelet
- Watches
