Greater Green Island Triathlon

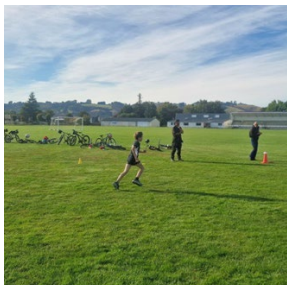
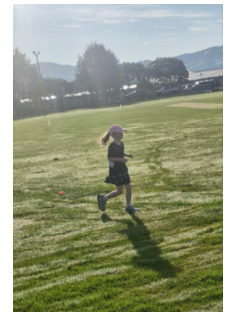

At our recent Board of Trustees meeting, we confirmed our Annual Implementation Plan, which has now been submitted to the Ministry of Education and is available on the Big Rock Primary School website (<https://www.bigrock.school.nz/about-us/doc-station/>). This plan sets out our key priorities, goals, and actions for the year, helping guide our focus on student learning and wellbeing.

We also reviewed several school policies, including lockdown procedures, physical restraint and seclusion, and attendance. Updated policies will be available on the school website under the “Policies” tab.

We are also very grateful to share that the school has received \$8,301 from the Brighton Trail Ride.
